

## **Be A Navigational Leader**

### **Deuteronomy 3:28**

- The body of Christ is in desperate need of leaders who can become great navigators.
- Navigate: to sail on or through; to steer or direct the course.
- We must be aware that navigating the church in this time is like navigating an army through a dangerous minefield.

#### **We Navigate By:**

- Leading people to what is morally right.
- Conquering the spirit of carnality.
- Dealing with the spirit of materialism.
- Confronting the spirit of greed and apathy.
- Combating the spirit of lukewarmness.
- Counteracting the seductive powers of demonic spirits.
- Helping to restore family values.
- Balancing the secular and the spiritual.

#### **Characteristics of Navigating Leaders:**

1. They are true leaders who lead the people from the front of the battle lines (Joshua 1:12-14).
2. They are not afraid of crisis (Ex. 14:13-18).
3. They are persistent (2 Corth. 4:16-18).
4. They control events (Prov. 21:22; 28:2).
5. They are in touch with their culture.
6. They are pathfinders and history makers in their culture (Matt. 9:16-17).
7. They are visionaries (go-getters).

8. They have a high level of confidence and faith in God (2 Timothy 1:7).
9. They seek the wisdom of God (James 1:5).
10. They are relationship-oriented (Prov. 20:28; 22:11; 27:9, 17).
