Review – Simple Obedience in Praying

- Simple – the instructions are clear.
- Prayer is vital for every Christian believer.
- The wrong motive: praying to be seen by men.
- The right motive: praying to be heard by God.

- Prayer is fellowshiping with the Father.
- Prayer is the pulse of the Spiritual life.
- Purpose: to teach us to be effective in personal prayer.
- Goal: for all of us to spend quality time in fellowshiping and communing with God.

Come to the Secret Place

Matt. 6:6; Psalm 91:1-16

- There is an invitation to come and spend quality time with our Heavenly Father.
- We must pray effectively in private before we can pray effectively in public.
- Our Father is waiting in the secret place.

- Secret place: a covering hiding place; a place of protection; concealed place; private hidden chamber.
- The enemy does not want us to go to the secret place because of the promises that will come into our lives.

Reasons for Coming into the Secret Place

1. The Father sees in secret; His eye is upon you to accept you (Jn. 1:48; Acts 9:11).
 - A. There must be a willingness to take time to pray.
 - B. A private place is necessary.

C. A place where I can have a personal relationship with God.

2. He will reward us openly (Psalm 91:1-16).

- Dwells – to sit down; to remain; to settle in the sense of taking up a homestead.
