Sowing and Reaping With Success

Philippians 4:14-19

- **Every one of us desire to live successfully in our lives, spiritually and naturally.**
- **Giving is not complete until receiving takes place!**

- **How to give successfully:**
 - 1. A gift should have a sweet smell.**
 - 2. It should be an acceptable sacrifice.**
 - 3. It should be pleasing to God.**
- **It is my desire that Love & Faith would be the most successful church in the world.**

- **There are Three Areas to Sow Successfully:**
 - 1. Paying the tithe (Mal. 3:6).**
 - **Tithe – to pay and to receive (10%).**
 - **The tithe is a sacrifice.**

○ **Seven things to know about the tithe:**

A. The tithe is an accursed thing.

- Anything that is accursed we cannot use it or keep it.

B. The tithe belongs to the local church.

C. The tithe releases God to demonstrate His power in our lives.

D. The tithe works in the supernatural.

E. The tithe stops the devil from destroying your incoming resources (v. 11).

F. The tithe stops the devil from destroying what you have.

G. The tithe stops the devil from pre-empting your plans.

- I can only tithe money.

2. The offering (Prov. 13:22).

- There are five acceptable pleasing offerings you can give:

- T-1. Treasure – the first offering we can offer to the Lord is the offering of our treasure.

- T-2. Time offering. Give our time in the service of the Lord.

- T-3. Talent offering. It is a natural gift (singing, creative dancing, playing of a musical instrument).

- T-4. Trade offering. It is a natural skill.

- T-5. Total offering. All of you – treasure, time, talent, and trade.

3. Sowing of alms (Matt. 26:6).

A. The poor need the gospel more than they need bread.

B. We cannot minister to the poor spiritually and overlook the physical.

C. There must be a balance (Matt 23:23).
