

# Agreeing with Each Other



**John 17:20**

- **The Spiritual Principle of Agreement – “God’s plan to crown our lives with peace.”**
- **Purpose: A communication, decision making, and problem solving principle.**
- **Goal: to achieve the peace that Jesus promised (John 17:27).**
- **Objective: to teach us how to rest in God (Heb. 4:1).**
  
- **Lesson #1 – What is agreement – to be harmonious, making harmonies together, to sound together.**
  
- **Lesson #2 – How to Agree with God**
  - A. We must agree with God in our communication**
  - B. I must agree with God in my heart.**
  - C. I must agree with God in my actions.**
  
- **Lesson #3 – Agree with Light (God).**
  - A. Where there is darkness there is no productivity.**
  - B. Where there is light there is productivity.**

## **Agreeing with Each Other**

### **John 17:20**

- **The enemy hates it when the husband, wife, and children come into agreement with each other.**
- **First, we must come into agreement with God, then we must come into agreement with each other.**
- **When the body of Christ agrees with each other, it shows the world who God is.**
  
- **We must clear up some misconceptions first.**
  - 1. Theology – the devil has used this to separate and divide us.**
  - 2. Our assignment is another trick of the enemy.**
  - 3. The doctrine must not conflict.**

- There are three questions we must ask and answer.
  1. Why do we agree with each other? Why is it necessary?
  2. Who do we agree with?
  3. How do I agree?
  
- Why do we agree with each other? Because of purpose, plan, and power.
  1. Purpose (John 17:20). When we agree with each other it shows the world that our God is God.
  2. Plan (Romans 12:1). There are many members within the body of Christ.
  3. Power (Acts 4:5-12, 17, 32). Each time one of us come into agreement with another the power is multiplied not added.
- The power is in the name of Jesus.
- Verse 32 – miracles happened in the early church because they had the power of togetherness.
- Who do we agree with? We can only agree with true believers.
- Who should we not agree with? (2 Cor. 6:14-18).
- How do we Agree (Matthew 18:18-20)? We agree by not allowing the devil to drive a wedge between us by unforgiveness.
