Deuteronomy 7:9

- Our Theme This Year is “The Year of Refreshing” – Everything Starts with God.
 - I believe it’s important that we Study the Attributes of God to us give a better understanding of God and how we can relate to Him.
 - The Attributes of God are the inherent characteristics of God.
 - God is unlike anyone or anything we could ever know or imagine. That is the Greatness of our God!
 - God is one of a kind, unique, distinct and without any comparison.
- There are (3) Three ways that God has revealed Himself.
 1. God has revealed Himself through creation. (Genesis 1)
 2. God has revealed Himself through the Written Word. (The Bible)
 3. God has revealed Himself through the Living Word. (Jesus Christ) (John 1:1-5, 14)
 - There are (3) Things that God wants to enhance in our lives through this study:
 1. God wants to enhance our visibility of Him.
 2. God wants to enhance our perception of Him.
 3. God wants to enhance the way we relate to Him.
- The purpose: is to drawer us closer to God.
 - The goal: To make us aware of God’s great love for us.

God Is Faithful

Deuteronomy 7:1-9

- Today we will be sharing in the Word of God the Attribute “God Is Faithful.” But before we get further into this subject I want to make you understand something about God – that is He is perfect in all of His ways.

1. What does it mean to say God is faithful? (Psalm 100:5)

- The word “faithful” means reliable, fidelity, firmness, stability, trustworthy, dependable or true to one’s word.
- Faithfulness points directly to God’s divine nature and character. God is not trying to be faithful – He is faithful.
- Faithfulness is essential to His very being; without it He wouldn’t be God.
- It’s impossible for God to be unfaithful, to do so would go against His divine nature. (2 Timothy 2:13)

A. Why should believers trust in God’s faithfulness?

1. God is faithful – He is True to Himself and True to His Word. God and His word are inseparable.
2. God will never violate Himself or His Word.
3. God will never cheat Himself or step outside of Himself nor compromise Himself. He is faithful 100% of the time.
4. God cannot lie. God said what He means and He means what He says. (Numbers 23:19, Titus 1:2, Hebrews 6:18)
5. God Word will always accomplish His purposes. (Isaiah 55:11)

B. The God we love and serve is perfect. In other words, God’s nature is perfect and so are His ways. (Deuteronomy 32:4)

- There is nothing lacking in God’s nature or character. God is holy and just – perfect and complete. He is void of any imperfections.
- God’s ways are always perfect. (Psalm 18:30)
- God’s faithfulness is absolutely perfect.
- God is faithful (His faithfulness exists within Himself). (2 Timothy 2:11-13)
- God is faithful in His work. (Psalm 33:1-4)
- God’s faithfulness gives us hope. (Hebrews 10:23)
- God is faithful to forgive sins. (1 John 1:9)
