

# Shifting Requires Us to Dig New Wells



**Genesis 26:12-25**

- Shift – to change; to change the place, position, or direction; to move from one assignment to another.
  - Wells – a deep hole full of water or oil.
  - A well is about more than water (Genesis 26).
  - Water – Life – life on earth cannot survive without water.
  - Transitions – the church of this 21<sup>st</sup> century is in transition.
  - Covid was sent to get the church's attention.
  - We must be ready for change.
  - Purpose: to teach us not to put a limit on God and to get excited about what is going to happen in your life.
  - Isaac limited himself to re-diggings old wells.
  - God wanted the vision He gave Abraham to be taken to a new level.
  - Old wells can contain dead animals.
- What are the New Wells?
1. Wells of new spiritual revelations (Joel 2:28-29).
    - God's revelation has seasons.
    - God wants to birth new moves.
    - A new army with a new mentality.
    - New spiritual technology.
  2. Wells of new knowledge and wisdom (Prov. 2:3-6).
    - Wealth is portable – (9 spiritual principles).
    - Learn new words, terminologies.
    - Change your definitions of things.
  3. New wells of prayer (Luke 18:1).
    - We use prayer to create.
    - We use prayer to travel into the future.
    - Train your eyes to see new things in the spirit.
    - Train your ears to hear new things in the spirit.
  4. Wells of new relationships (Prov. 13:20).
    - Your relationships will determine your successes or your failures.

**5. Wells of wealth and prosperity (Deut. 8:18).**

- Streams of wealth.
- Think of what God want us to do with wealth and power.
- Get a financial mentor.

**6. Wells of praise and worship (John 4:23).**

- Learning to touch God with voice, tears, and finances.
- Let your spirit sing a new song to release miracles.
- Praise and worship are vehicles that takes you to God's realm – faith, power, and anointing.

**7. Wells of love (John 13:34-35).**

- Uzziah – 2 Chronicles 26 – 16 years old
