Genesis 8:22

- Review – Spiritual Principle of Sowing and Reaping – “God’s plan to provide for our lives.”
 - God’s plan to cause His will to reproduce after His kind.
 - Purpose: A faith building principle.
 - Objective: how to receive the provisions of God.
 - Goal: to super abound and meet the needs of others.
- Lesson # 1- Sowing with a Clean Heart
 - A. A clean heart sows unselfishly.
 - B. A clean heart sows with the proper motivation.
 - C. A clean heart sows with clean hands.
 - Lesson # 2 – Sowing and Reaping with Knowledge
 - Sow – to give the things of God according to His plan.
 - Reap – to receive the harvest of God that is provided for us through Jesus Christ.
 - A. Everyone has the ability to successfully sow and reap.
 - B. We must understand the seed.
 - C. We must understand the harvest.

Sowing Like God

Genesis 8:22

- God created the principle of sowing and reaping.
 - When we sow like God, we are going to reap the God kind of harvest.
1. When God sows, He sows His best (John 3:16).
 - A. True love compels one to give their best possession.
 - B. True love compels one to give their best effort (John 15:11).
 2. God sowed for our sakes (2 Cor. 3:3-6, 17).
 - A. When I sow for your sake, my heart is in it.
 - B. When I sow for your sake, it is a pleasure not a burden.

- 3. God always sows in faith (John 14:1).**
- A. When you sow in faith you make provision for the harvest.**
 - B. When you sow in faith you sow abundantly.**
 - C. When you sow in faith you sow consistently.**
 - D. When you sow in faith you sow patiently.**
