John 3:16

- The Spiritual Principles that we have been taught are:
 1. The Principle of Organization – God’s plan to simplify my life.
 2. The Principle of Sow and Reap – God’s plan to provide for my life.
 3. The Principle of Stewardship – God’s plan to fulfill my life.
 4. The Principle of Obedience – God’s plan to reward my life.
 5. The Principle of Authority – God’s plan to protect my life.
 6. The Principle of Agreement – God’s plan to crown my life with peace.

- The Spiritual Principle of Unconditional Love – God’s plan to keep us from failing.
- God’s plan to keep His will from returning unto Him void.
- Purpose: It is a proper attitude building principle.
- Goal: to have victory over every evil circumstance.
- Objective: how to have good success with God and man.

Understanding Unconditional Love

- Unconditional love means to be limited by no conditions.
- For one to love unconditionally, we must be committed to something that is greater than the object of our love.
- In order not to fail that which I am committed to, I must note three things.
 - That which I am committed to must be:
 1. Infallible – incapable of making a mistake.
 2. Unchangeable – changeless, fixed.
 3. Dependable – reliable, trustworthy.

- The mystery to God’s love for us is that God is committed to, and He loves His Word.
- The greatest love that God can express to us is to stay committed to His Word.
- The greatest love we can show to another is to stay under the authority of God’s Word.

- **The case of Joseph and unconditional love (Gen. 37 – 50).**
- **One great lesson we can learn from chapter 39 of Genesis is that the enemy will always challenge whatever you believe.**
- **In Genesis 40, the butler and the baker of Pharaoh had dreams and Joseph interpreted them.**
- **It is hard to keep on loving after you have helped people and they keep forgetting you.**
- **Behind every excuse is success.**
- **The person who refuses to forgive is the one who always suffers.**
