## **Mental Organization**

### **Romans 7:14**

- **After the fall, man became internally and externally disorganized; spiritually and mentally disorganized.**
  - **Your human spirit may be perfectly organized by the Holy Spirit, but you can still live a defeated life as a Christian.**
- **In order to become mentally organized:**
- 1. We must recognize our human limitation.**
    - **Romans 7:14-25; 8:1-5 – Paul may be writing about two kinds of persons in this Scripture.**
    - A. An unregenerate person.**
    - B. A saved person who has not allowed his human spirit to organize his mind.**
    - **Paul gives us a solution to living an overcoming life – stop living in the flesh and start living in the Spirit.**
  - 2. I must allow the Word of God to come to the “Meeting Place” (Hebrews 4:12).**
    - **Body – world consciousness – things that come into contact with the material world – our senses**
    - **Soul (mind) – self-consciousness – comprises of intellect, will, and emotions, reveals our personalities.**

- **Spirit (human spirit) - God consciousness – the part we commune with God and the only way we are able to apprehend and worship Him.**
  - **We cannot worship God in our own ability.**
- 3. We must mortify the deeds of the flesh (Rom. 8:13).**
- 4. We must renew our minds with the Word of God (Romans 12:1-2).**
- **The greatest battles are fought in the mind.**
