

The Refreshing of the Holy Spirit



John 14:12-17

- The Holy Spirit is indispensable. He is the most important person in the earth. His voice is the most important voice in the earth that every believer must know.
- The Holy Spirit sends us daily alerts as (believer) of things going on within us and around us, but the problem is we have shut Him off or silenced Him.
- The Holy Spirit helps us to live a godly Christian life (He will not make us live right).
- The Holy Spirit's work in the life of believers assisting them in accomplishing God's Kingdom Agenda for their lives.
- The Holy Spirit must be actively involved in the life of every believer. If not, the believer can easily become complacent in their state of being.
- Purpose: to make us aware of the Holy Spirit involvement in our daily lives. To help us become sensitive to the voice of the Holy Spirit's leading and direction for our lives.
- Goal: to strengthen our relationship with the Holy Spirit so that our lives and our witness will glorify Jesus Christ.
- Spiritual Principles – Grace, Authority, Obedience, Agreement, Faith
- Objective Lessons – (1) The Holy Spirit's Involvement in Jesus Christ's Life (2) The Holy Spirit's Involvement in the Believer's Life (3) Getting to Know the Voice of God (4) How to Position Ourselves to Hear from God.

Statements about the Holy Spirit

John 14:12-17

1. The Holy Spirit is always moving in the life of every true believer. The believer's life should be progressing and not regressing.
2. When the Holy Spirit is progressively involved in our daily lives our lives will be fruitful, our lives will be prosperous, our lives will be a blessing to others, our lives will be a witness for Jesus Christ.

3. The Holy Spirit is the executive power of the Godhead. He is actively involved in executing the will of the Father and Son in the lives of the believer. (John 16:13-15)
4. The Holy Spirit is moving and He is ready to move swiftly, and mightily through His church (believers) to meet the need of a groaning planet. (Romans 8:22, Acts 2:17, Joel 2:28-32)
5. The Holy Spirit is moving, convicting the hearts of sinners of their need for Jesus Christ. (John 16:7-11)
6. The Holy Spirit is moving in the hearts of believers to surrender everything to the will of Christ.
7. The Holy Spirit is moving in the hearts of believers to worship Jesus Christ; to lift Him up, to glorify His name (not men or things), to represent His Glorious Kingdom on the earth. (John 12:32)
8. When the Holy Spirit is moving in the hearts of believers there is liberty (freedom). (2 Corinthians 3:17)
9. The Holy Spirit is moving in the hearts of believers. We won't be selfish. We will love others including our enemies, we will serve others, we will bless others, we will pray for others, we will encourage others, we will be kind to others and we will forgive others. (Matthew 5:44, 1 Thessalonians 5:11, Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 3:13)
