

# Study of The Attributes of God



**Deuteronomy 32:1-4**

- Theme This Year is “The Year of Refreshing” – Everything Starts with God.
- I believe it’s important that we Study the Attributes of God to us give a better understanding of God and how we can relate to Him.
- I believe some of the misconceptions about God is that He is not relatable, unresponsive, uncaring, unloving, unforgiving, uninformed, unfaithful, unhinged, forever changing.
- The Attributes of God – the inherent characteristics of God.

**A. There are (3) three ways that God has revealed Himself**

1. God has revealed Himself through creation. (Genesis 1)
2. God has revealed Himself through the Written Word. (The Bible)
3. God has revealed Himself through the Living Word. (Jesus Christ) (John 1:1-5, 14)

○ There are (3) things that God wants to enhance in our lives through this study:

1. God wants to enhance our visibility of Him.
2. God wants to enhance of perception of Him.
3. God wants to enhance the way we relate to Him.

- The Purpose: to draw us closer to God.
- The Goal: to make us aware of God’s great love for us.
- Spiritual Principle: Authority, Unconditional love, Agreement, Faith, Grace
- Objective Lessons: God is Infinite, God is Immutable, God is Self-sufficient, God is Faithful, God is God, God is Just, God is Merciful, God is Gracious, God is Loving, God is Holy, God is Omnipotent, God is Omniscient, God Omnipresent

**B. The Bible is God’s written revelation of who He is and what He has done in redemptive history.**

1. We must first understand that God is both incomprehensible and knowable.

2. The word “know” denotes having a personal and intimate relationship with God.
3. The word “incomprehensible” means impossible to comprehend or to fully understand.

**C. Here are Four things to remember about God.**

1. God is knowable.
2. God is personal.
3. God is relational.
4. God is sufficient.
