External Organization

Mark 7:5

- We must be externally organized in three ways:
 1. We must organize what we do.
 2. We must organize what we have.
 3. We must organize what we have authority over.
- All three of these operate and proceed from out of the inside (Mark 7:5-18).
- Everything that is evil starts from the inside.
- The problem is not with how you let another person cause you to fall.
- Do not confuse organization with discipline.
- Discipline – an automatic response to enforce obedience.
- Organization – to arrange in a proper workable manner, according to priority.
- 1. It is from the inside that we organize what we do (Gal. 5:9).
 - Verse 16 – we must allow the “Word of God” come to the “Meeting Place.”
- 2. It is from the inside that we organize what we have.

- We must take care of the natural proceeds from out of the inside.
 - By observation we can tell:
 - A. The value we place on our natural possession.
 - B. Our gratitude towards the natural possession God has given us.

- 3. From the inside we organize what we have authority over.
 - A. Children (1 Peter 5:1-9).
 - B. Taking oversight.

4. Unable to hold a steady course.
5. Lack of peace.
6. Constant depression.
7. Inability to deal with normal pressures of life.
