Matthew 25:15

- Review – Spiritual Principle of Sowing and Reaping – “God’s plan to provide for our lives.”
 - Sow – give the things of God according to the plan of God.
 - Reap – to receive the harvest of God that is provided for us through Jesus Christ.
- Lesson #1 – The key to successful sowing and reaping is “The Condition of the Heart.”
 - The size of the gift alone will not determine the size of the harvest.
 - “Sowing with a Clean Heart”
- A. Sow unselfishly.
 - B. Sow with the proper motivation.
 - C. Sow with clean hands.

Sowing and Reaping with Knowledge

Matthew 25:14

- Knowledge – knowing, understanding, intelligence, wisdom, discernment, and skill.
 - In order to sow we must have a seed.
 - In order to reap there must be a harvest.
 - If we desire to have seeds to sow that we might have a harvest to give into the lives of other, God will bring it to pass.
1. Everyone has the ability to successfully sow and reap (Matt. 25:14).
 - God starts everyone out according to their ability.
 - When the harvest comes, the wise steward will deliver the entire harvest into the hands of the Lord.
 2. We must understand the seed (Mark 4:14).
 - Seed – sperma – to reproduce after its kind.
 - The only purpose for a seed is to get it out of your possession.
 - Sowing and reaping is the foundation to understanding business and economics.

- **The seed produces the harvest.**
 - A. The seed must be sown into good soil so that it can produce a good harvest.**
 - B. The wrong soil can kill the seed.**

- 3. We must understand the harvest (Gal. 6:7-10).**
 - **Sowing to the Spirit means – sowing the things of God according to the plan of God.**
 - **A successful harvest should produce three things:**
 - 1. An abundance – plentiful – profit above your investment.**
 - 2. Replenish – the reinvestment for the next harvest.**
 - 3. Abound – a supernatural overflow.**
