1 Cor. 2:9-12

- Review – Spiritual Principle of Organization – “God’s plan to simplify my life.”
 - Purpose: to teach how to live a consistent godly lifestyle.
 - Objective: how to organize the organism.
 - Goal: to be an effective witness for the Lord.
- The Devastation of Disorganization
 1. Devastation #1 – We become negatively fearful.
 2. Devastation #2 – Man becomes guilty.
 3. Devastation #3 – Man feels the need of a crutch.
 - No one knows you like your spirit that dwells on the inside of you.

The Process of Organization

1. The Holy Spirit organizes the human spirit.
 2. After the Holy Spirit organizes the human spirit, the human spirit then organizes the mind of man.
 3. It is the spirit filled mind that organizes the body which is external.
- The Holy Spirit knows exactly what we need to do to bring our lives in line with the will of God.
 - Before any internal organization can take place, man must come to the realization that he needs a savior.
1. We must be born again (2 Cor. 5:17).
 2. We need to get this organism organized.
 3. Everyone that is born again that will allow the Holy Spirit to live in them, knows exactly what they need to do to bring their lives in line with God’s will.
 4. The purpose of organizing the organism is so that the organism will be able to function in an organization.
- Organism – to bring together the trinity of man to make him functional.
 - Organization – the body of Christ.

- **The mission of this organization:**

- 1. The organization must glorify God.**
- 2. It must go out to seek and to save that which is lost.**
- 3. To destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8).**

- **Example of Organizing the Organism:**

- 1. The United States military.**
- 2. When we are organized, when we finish basic training, we are going to receive something (Acts 1:4-8).**
 - **Power – dynamite – the power to disassemble, power to assemble and the power to correct.**
- 3. When we are organized, we will be something – witnesses.**

- **There are two ways to be something:**

- 1. We take off the old man (Eph. 4:19-32).**
- 2. We put on the new man.**
