Obedience to God Brings the Reward Genesis 12:1

- We must develop a sense of urgency to obey God (Psalm 81:11).
 - Someone will suffer if you and I don’t obey.
1. We must be taught to obey.
 2. We must learn obedience.
- Reward means recompense.
 - Reward is what we receive for our actions.
1. The requirements of godly rewards (Gen. 12:1-4).
 - A. We must sacrifice.
 - B. We must walk by faith.
 - C. We must see God as our source.
 - D. We must know God to the point where He is so real in our lives that what we believe, we will act on.
 - Whenever God gives you something it may not be for you, but for you to bless others (Heb. 11:8, 17).
 - Most people only see the verdict, they were not present when the trial was going on.

E. God must know us.

2. What is the reward of obeying God?

- **When we obey God, we activate the promises of the Kingdom of God in our lives, and we do it now in this lifetime.**

3. How do we receive the reward in our lives?

- **The reward is activated by the disposition and not the position.**
- **Disposition – our attitudes and actions.**
- **When you decide to walk with God, you must forget the past and move on.**
